<p>Shall the previously authorized increase in tax limitation on all taxable property in White Lake Charter Township, Oakland County, that expired in 2017 be renewed and the Township be authorized to levy an amount not to exceed 4.0371 mills (\$4.0371 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable property for a period of four (4) years, 2018 to 2021, inclusive, for the purpose of operating, equipping, providing personnel, constructing and purchasing for the police department or any other purpose authorized by law for police protection service? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect in the first year (2018) if the millage is approved and levied by the Township is approximately \$4,485,000.</p>

<p>Shall the previously authorized increase in tax limitation on all taxable property in White Lake Charter Township, Oakland County, that expired in 2017 be renewed and the Township be authorized to levy an amount not to exceed 1.8792 mills (\$1.8792 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable property for a period of four (4) years, 2018 to 2021, inclusive, for the purpose of operating, equipping, providing personnel, constructing and purchasing for the fire department or any other purpose authorized by law for fire protection service? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect in the first year (2018) if the millage is approved and levied by the Township is approximately \$2,088,000.</p>

<p>Shall the previously authorized increase in tax limitation on all taxable property in White Lake Charter Township, Oakland County, that expired in 2017 be renewed and the Township be authorized to levy an amount not to exceed 0.3861 mill (\$0.3861 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable property for a period of eight (8) years, 2018 to 2025, inclusive, for the purpose of operating the White Lake Township Library or any other purpose authorized by law for library service? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect in the first year (2018) if the millage is approved and levied by the Township is approximately \$429,000. By law, revenue from this millage will be disbursed to the White Lake Township Library.</p>
