Garbage Service

Your home is part of a Special Assessment District to provide trash removal through 2011.

Charge for 2011 - \$159.00

Charges for this service are included on the December tax bill. In the case of a new home, the township will pro-rate the charge from the date of occupancy permit and will send a special bill for the current year and possibly the next year. Charges from then on will appear on the winter tax bill.

Large Items

No charge for most large items. Call Allied Waste 48 hours in advance to arrange a pick up. All appliances containing chlorofluorocarbons (CFC's) will be picked up at no charge.

Paint

Contact Allied Waste or see handout.

Garbage Cans

Large plastic wheeled carts will be provided by Allied Waste.

Recycling

Contact Allied Waste or see handout

Construction Debris

Allow 3-32 gallon containers of construction debris or equivalent.

Exempt Items

Tires, rims, cement, stones are not covered by the contract.

Brush

Should be bundled in lengths of 4 feet or less and 3"-4" in diameter

Christmas Trees

Will be picked up for 3 weeks after the Holiday.

Compost

From **April 1st-November 30th**, use **brown compost bags** for grass, small twigs or leaves or use **garbage cans clearly marked yard waste**. Limit 20 bags. Composting is done by a separate garbage truck on your regular pick up day. Any compost to be picked up after the composting season ends must be stored until the next composting season begins.

Holidays - pickup will be the day following the Holiday

Memorial Day - July 4th - Labor Day
Thanksgiving - Christmas - New Years
