**Plans are required** for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and as amended and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal. PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

**V. HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT**

I hereby certify the Plumbing work described on this permit application shall **be installed by myself in my own home**, which I am living in or will occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the Plumbing code and **shall not be enclosed, covered up, or put into operation** until it has **been inspected and approved** by the Plumbing Inspector. I will cooperate with the Plumbing Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections

**VI. APPLICANT SIGNATURE**

Section 23a of the State Construction Code Act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. **GENERAL:** Plumbing work shall not be started until the permit application has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.**

When ready for an inspection, call the Building Department to schedule inspections. You will need to provide the job location and permit number.

**EXPIRATION OF PERMIT:** A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work.
