



## **WHITE LAKE TOWNSHIP UTILITY MAINTENANCE FOREMAN**

The Charter Township of White Lake is accepting applications for a Utility Maintenance Foreman in the water and sewer division.

This position will oversee, schedule and perform duties and tasks to operate and maintain Township water and sewer systems. The Foreman will oversee and organize day to day duties and responsibilities of DPS Utilities Maintenance Workers and report to the Department of Public Services Director. Other responsibilities include performing inspections and/or repairs of facilities, record keeping of inspections and repairs and ensuring that all aspects of the water system are functioning properly. This position requires a rotation of on call hours 7 days per week to respond to emergencies and SCADA alarms after hours.

Minimum qualifications include 5 years of experience in construction, maintenance or repair in Public Works or in a related field. A D-1 license to operate iron filtration and an S-1 certification to operate the water distribution system is preferred. Candidates not currently possessing these licenses will be required to obtain them within one (1) year from date of hire or promotion. Knowledge of equipment, facilities, materials and maintenance and repair activities required. Must possess a mechanical aptitude.

Wages are based on qualifications and include a comprehensive benefit plan including health insurance, optical, dental, and life insurance. Benefits also include a pension plan and paid time off for holidays and vacation.
